Parents and Spectators

- ✓ Do not argue with the officials; they are volunteers!
- ✓ Do not coach from the sidelines or shout at a player that makes a mistake.
- ✓ Stay off the pitch during matches.
- ✓ Show the players you enjoy watching the game no matter what the result.
- ✓ Respect other players by giving the club good notice if you are unable to attend a game.

Players

- ✓ Play football because you enjoy it, not to please others.
- ✓ Learn the rules and play by them.
- ✓ Accept the referee's decision; don't argue with the officials.
- ✓ Shake hands with the opposition at the end of every game, no matter what the result.
- ✓ Always encourage teammates.
- ✓ Always be on time for the match with clean boots and kit.
- ✓ Always arrive on time for training and matches.
- ✓ Listen to the coach/manager who is there for you!
- ✓ Help pack up the equipment after training and the match.
- ✓ Always try your best.
